1. System requirements

BitFlashX is designed for modern Windows systems. Older operating systems are not supported.

Operating system	Windows 10 or Windows 11 (64-bit)
CPU	Modern x64 processor recommended
RAM	4 GB minimum (8 GB recommended)
Storage	200 MB free space for installer and logs
Network	Optional (only for downloading updates or documentation)

2. Installation

Download the installer from the official website only. If a checksum is provided, verify it before running the installer.

- 1 Download the Windows installer (or portable package) from bitflashx.com.
- 2 Run the installer as a standard user (administrator rights may be requested depending on your system policy).
- 3 Launch BitFlashX from the Start menu or desktop shortcut.
- 4 On first launch, allow the application to initialize the flash engine and create its local data folder.

Tip: If you use the portable package, keep it in a stable folder path (for example: `C:\\BitFlashX\\`) to avoid permission issues.

3. Activation and license plans

BitFlashX uses device-bound activation. A license is associated with a device fingerprint to control access and plan limits.

Plan code	Duration	Flash node cap
D14_70	14 days	70 BTC
D30_250	30 days	250 BTC
M3_500	3 months	500 BTC
M6_700	6 months	700 BTC
Y1_1000	1 year	1000 BTC

- 1 Open the Activation screen in the application.
- 2 Copy your Device ID / Fingerprint shown by the software.
- 3 Enter your license key (or import the license file provided by support).
- 4 Confirm activation. The software will validate the license locally and enable the features of your plan.

4. Running a flash engine

Use BitFlashX to flash Bitcoin transaction scenarios. The console displays node-style logs that describe each step of the flow.

- Select the flash mode.
- Enter a destination address and an amount.
- Start the engine and watch the execution logs.
- Review policy checks, status panels, and final result.
- Use the log panel to export or copy messages for review.

5. Security and anti-scam guidance

- Official domain: bitflashx.com. Always verify the URL before downloading.
- BitFlashX has no duplicate or mirror websites. Any clone is a scam.
- Never share your license key, device ID, or activation files with third parties.
- Support will not ask for sensitive information in private messages.
- If a checksum is provided, verify file integrity before installing.

6. Troubleshooting

Activation fails	Check that your Device ID matches the one provided during activation, then retry. If the device changed, contact support.
Software does not start	Reinstall the latest official build. Ensure Windows 10-11 64-bit and required permissions.
Flash is blocked by limits	Your plan may have reached its flash cap or expired. Review your plan details.
Download looks suspicious	Only download from bitflashx.com . Avoid mirrors and third-party links.
